

## MONDAY 9.15.25 - Matthew 25:31-34

<sup>31</sup>“When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his glorious throne. <sup>32</sup>All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. <sup>33</sup>He will put the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. <sup>34</sup>“Then the King will say to those on his right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world.

Today’s scripture might lead you to think that our salvation is based on good works. This is not true, but what is Christ saying? He is saying that if you truly know me and have invited me into your life, then my compassion, generosity, and love will flow through you into the lives of all who are in need. If you are showing these things without Me in your life they will mean nothing in terms of your salvation. On that final day many who believe they are heaven bound will be disappointed to find out that it is not about the good they have done but about the good Christ has done through them. Is the love within you because Christ is in you? If so, you can look forward to the day Christ says “well done enter in. If not, perhaps today will be the day you ask Christ into your life so you will not hear the words “depart from me I do not know you.

## TUESDAY 9.16.25 - Revelation 20:4-5

Following the seven-year Tribulation Period, Jesus Christ will return to earth to set up His kingdom. He will rule and reign over the entire world. Jesus’ kingdom is often referred to as the Millennial Kingdom. The word “millennium” means a thousand years (a phrase used six times in Revelation 20:1-7). It is derived from the Latin words *mille* (thousand) and *annus* (year). When Jesus returns to this planet, He will defeat His enemies, confine Satan to a bottomless pit, and bodily raise to life Old Testament

and Tribulation Period believers. The Millennial Kingdom is the kingdom of God on earth under the rule of the Messiah. In the Old and New Testament Scriptures, God promised to establish a theocratic kingdom on earth where man would ultimately enjoy the restoration of a state of paradise, which was lost after the rebellious sin of our first parents, Adam and Eve.

## WEDNESDAY 9.17.25 - Matthew 28:18-20

It’s possible for a church to conduct a multitude of programs and every kind of activity imaginable—and yet accomplish nothing of eternal value. A church must know its mission and design its ministries to fulfill that mission. What is the mission of Shiloh Bible Church? What are we supposed to be doing as a local church? We don’t need to survey our congregation or take a vote of our membership to discover the answer. Before Jesus ascended to heaven, He gave the Church its mission—“make disciples” (Matthew 28:19). How is that accomplished? The answer is two-fold: by evangelizing unbelievers (“Therefore, go ...”) and edifying believers (“... baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you”). Pray that Shiloh would be faithful in fulfilling the mission that God has entrusted to us.

## THURSDAY 9.18.25 - 1 Chronicles 16:24-27

Not many of us consider ourselves evangelists or even good at evangelism. Most of us do not make a practice of exercising our tongues regarding evangelism, mostly because either we are

afraid of the reaction or because we do not think we have much to say regarding the matter. I Chronicles 16 must disabuse us of that notion, however. Our God is to be feared above all Gods! Wait, there are not even supposed to be other gods, yet if there were, ours is the greatest of them all.

Our view into the heavens, the spring growth, summer weather, fall colors and winter splendor ought to be sufficient to move us. Our own salvation should motivate us to speak about what God has done for us. Daily He meets us where we are and supplies all we need. Troubles and woes, praise and pleasures all bring glory to Him. That is worth telling. That is evangelism.


