- Instrumentalists

Hospitality

- Door Greeters (Hold doors open as people enter the building, offer a friendly greeting.)
- Lobby Hosts (Welcome people to Shiloh, help locate key areas, identify next steps, provide general info)
- Ushers (Distribute bulletins, help during service as needed)
- Follow-Up (check in with guests; thank them for visiting—phone and/or personal note)

Discipleship

- Children's Sunday School Teachers (9:45AM and 11AM)
- Children's Assistant (9:45AM and 11AM)
- Nursery Care
- Pathway Partner (Help people determine where they are on the discipleship pathway)
- Mentor (be available to meet one-on-one/in small settings to disciple others)
- Host (Perhaps you are not called to teach but could make sure participants are welcomed and comfortable.)

Health/Safety

- Security Team
- Health Team

Prayer and Care

- Prayer Partners (Available during response times in services and after services to pray about individual needs)
- Follow-up Partners (Check-in during the week with those who asked for prayer on Sunday.)
- Minister to the Firsts (serve those who are going through the first year of loss: birthdays, holidays, etc. with notes, calls, visits, invitations, etc.)
